PERSONAL PROPERTY SUMMARY

Yasuichiro ABE, Registered No. 11542

This man signed a Declaration on April 10, 1942. He was evacuated on July 21, 1942. On March 19, 1943 we received an acknowledgement from Yasuichiro ABE that the personal property which he had declared at 1118 Powell Street had been sold or otherwise disposed of prior to his evacuation.

He declared \$95.00 in War Savings Certificates in his own possession. These did not come under the control of the Custodian.

He declared a Life Insurance Policy for \$2,000.00 in the Manufacturers Life Insurance Company. On January 29th we received from the Life Insurance Company a cheque for \$998.00, payable to this man and his wife, in settlement of claims under Policy No. 359368. This cheque is being held in this office for a reply from ABE to our letter of January 29th, in which we asked if he wished us to settle the claim of the Vancouver General Hospital from these funds.

This file reveals no other property of any kind.

Dear Sir & Madam:

Attached hereto is Custodian cheque for the sum of \$150.00 payable to you. These funds were derived from the cheque for \$998.00 which was received from the Manufacturers Life Insurance Co. and placed in your account as requested in your letter of February 2nd.

We have remitted to the Vancouver General Hospital the sum of \$11.15 from your funds in full settlement of the claim filed by the hospital against Mrs. ABE. The sum of \$836.85 is standing to the credit of a joint account in your names, and this money will be available to you upon request.

In your declaration to the Custodian, you reported some household effects left at your former residence at Vancouver on March 19, 1943. You reported to this office that these chattels had been sold or otherwise disposed of by yourself prior to your evacuation.

You declared \$95.00 in War Saving Certificates in your own possession. These did not come under the control of this office.

It would appear that we have accounted for all the property of every kind left by you in the protected area, which vested in the Custodian and in order that you may confirm this and acknowledge the cheque, we enclose a stamped addressed envelope for your convenience in replying.
