



On January oth, 1945, we moved goods from 111 Steveston Highway marked with the name "K. 10500. Na".

We wrote to your father, Mr. Highitary Todouawa, and he advised us in his letter of March 20th, 1946, that these goods all belonged to him, but that he wished your account to be credited with the proceeds. We have accordingly gredited your account with the sum of \$41.54, being the net amount received for these goods when they were sold at auction. These were sold for the sum of \$195.00, which was remitted to on on July 27th, 1945. The prices obtained were in accordance with the appraised values of am independent appraiser. We have received information from the custodian, sell fishing equipment, from which you received the proceeds livect.

According to information supplied to this office you were the registered owner of a finning vessel, the "MUST/"M.Y.", which was sold through the Japanese Fishing Vessel Disposal Committee for the not sam of \$661.00, and this amount was paid to you on April 27th, 1942.

You declared a life insurance policy with the Sun Life Insurance Company of Canada in the sum of \$2000.00, the beneficiary being your father.
