This 61-year old Cook, a Naturalized-Canadian, from Premier, B. C., signed a Custodian "JP" declaration form on the 30th March, 1942. He was evacuated on the 5th May, 1942.

His wife, Inuyo (File 10363) signed a Custodian "No Property" card on the 3rd June, 1942. She was evacuated on the 3rd June, 1942.

The following is a summary of the contents of this file as disclosed by a review made today.

Bills Receivable: Declared the sum of \$225.00 to be owing to him by H. Mochida, Prince Rupert, B. C. No action has been taken by this office to date but Heisaku MOCHIDA (File 1528) is now being asked for information regarding the present position of this debt.

Bonds, Shares, etc.: Shares (500) in Moneta Gold Mines Ltd., and War Savings Certificates (\$425.00) declared by this evacuee, remained in his possession and did not come under the administration of this office.

The transfer of 350 shares in the Calgary & Edmonton Corporation to Scholey & Company and the payment of proceeds (\$534.27) direct to this shareholder by A. E. Jukes & Co. Ltd., was approved by this office May 7/43.



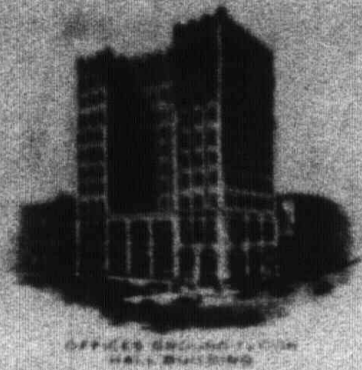

Dear Sir:-

We have done some business with a Japanese of the name of Sam Fukuyama of Premier, B.C., and are at the present time holding some certificates for him for safe-keeping, which are fully paid for. Our business with him is handled through a friend of ours in Premier, who is the Postmaster among other things, and we have received a request from him that the Japanese would like to have his certificates forwarded to him.

So far as we can make out under the Regulations which were published over your signature during the last day or two, we are permitted to do business with any Japanese who is living in this country and who has not been detained under the Defence of Canada Regulations. It would, therefore, seem to be in order for us to send the securities to our friend the Postmaster with instructions for him to deliver the certificates to Fukuyama if he is at liberty and has not been detained. If he is under detention, we will ask for the securities to be returned to us.

If the above is in order, will you kindly advise us to this effect.

This file is up for review and we take advantage of this opportunity to give you a brief resume of our administration of your affairs.

Real Property: In the "JP" declaration form signed by you on the 30th March, 1942, you declared that you owned no Real Property (land and buildings) in the protected areas of British Columbia.

Personal Property: You also declared that your personal effects (chattels) were in your possession.

Bills Receivable: Under the heading "Moneys owing to you" you listed the sum of \$225.00 as owing to you by H. Mochida of Prince Rupert. Our records show this debt to be still outstanding and we would be obliged if you would let us know whether or not a settlement has been effected between you and Mr. Mochida.

Bonds, Shares, etc.: Shares (500) in Moneta Gold Mines Ltd., and War Savings Certificates (\$425.00) declared by you, remained in your possession and did not come under our administration.

The transfer of shares (350) in the Calgary & Edmonton Corporation Ltd. from your name to that of Scholey & Company and the payment of proceeds (\$534.27) to you direct by A. E. Jukes & Company, Ltd., was approved by this office on May 7th, 1943.

Bank Accounts: A balance of \$779.75 in an account with the Bank of Montreal, Vancouver, declared by you, remained under your control and did not come under our administration.

Funds: The Custodian holds no funds, nor other assets, in your name at the present time.

Re: Heisaku MOCHIDA - Reg. No. 10439.

In your "JP" declaration dated Mar. 30/42, you listed a debt of \$225.00 as owing to you by H. Mochida of Prince Rupert.

We have been corresponding with the above evacuee with regard to this claim and are now in receipt of a letter from him reading: "A claim of \$225.00 by Magoichi Fukuyama against me is in connection with old business deal of twenty years ago and I have contra account against him in fact 5 cents heavier than his claim. That was why I did not bother to include it in my declaration form at my evacuation. At any rate, this is also a case to be settled between ourselves. Kindly strike this off from your record."

In view of this response there would appear to be nothing further that we can do in the matter and we leave you to take any direct action you may decide on. Mr. Mochida's address is: Taylor Lake, B. C.

We might add that Mr. Mochida's funds having been remitted to him he doubtless has adequate funds with which to implement any settlement you may make with him.
