So far as we can make out under the Regulations which were published over your signature during the last day or two, we are permitted to do business with any Japanese who is living in this country and who has not been detained under the Defence of Canada Regulations. It would, therefore, seem to be in order for us to send the securities to our friend the Postmaster with instructions for him to deliver the certificates to Fukuyama if he is at liberty and has not been detained. If he is under detention, we will ask for the securities to be returned to us. If the above is in order, will you kindly advise us to this effect. Yours very truly.
