

GENERAL SUMMARY

Re: Tomogoro KONISHI, Reg. No. 07387

This man signed a declaration to the Custodian on April 10, 1942. He was evacuated on May 19, 1942.

In his declaration he reported a boat "T.K." in custody at New Westminster. The records of the Japanese Fishing Vessels Disposal Committee show that this boat was sold and the net proceeds in the amount of \$690.50 were paid to KONISHI on September 4, 1942.

In his declaration he reported \$10.00 in War Savings Certificates in his home. In September, 1942, this man redeemed these War Savings Certificates for cash. This did not come under the control of this office.
