



PERSONAL PROPERTY SUMMARY

This file reveals that Kenji TATEBE owned no real property in any protected area of H.C. and did not carry any fire insurance.

CHATTELS: TATEBE made his declaration to the Custodian on March 17/42 and was evacuated on June 3/42. He declared chattels as shown on Chattel Schedule on file, the steam press in storage at Pease Van & Storage, and the remainder of the goods at 526 E. Cordova St. The steam press was removed from storage to our warehouse and sold at auction for the net sum of \$455.09 and this sum was credited to the account of TATEBE with this office. Storage charges owing to Pease Van & Storage in the sum of \$3.00 were paid by this office out of funds remitted to us by TATEBE for this purpose.

3 cartons were shipped on March 31/44 at the request of TATEBE. A trunk was shipped to him on May 20/43, but apparently we sent the wrong trunk. The file does not make it clear whether this mistake was rectified or not.

The boiler and sawdust burner, steam pipes, 2 rolls linoleum, drop leaf table, and some tools were sold at auction on Jan. 18/45 for the net sum of \$28.27 and this sum credited to his account with the Custodian.

The counters, showcase, one bed and one table were left with the owner of 1685 Davie St. in lieu of rent.

2 sewing machines, bedroom furniture, other than the bed, 7 chairs, and 2 couches were not found by the Custodian. TATEBE may have disposed of these himself prior to his evacuation.

A stove, one roll linoleum, closet, 3 ironing boards, 1 tank, bucket, board and tiles, inventoried by the Custodian, are missing. I have checked the files of others who had goods left at 526 E. Cordova St. but do not find these articles on any of their files.

SPECIFIED ARTICLES: On March 9/42 TATEBE surrendered the following to the R.C.M.P.:

1 General Electric radio
1 kodak camera

The radio was sold at auction for the net sum of \$33.02 and this sum was credited to his account with the Custodian.

The camera was mailed to him on June 3/46.

WAR SAVINGS CERTIFICATES: He declared one \$5.00 War Savings Certificate in the name of his daughter Shizuko. This was not brought under the control of the Custodian.

Prior to his departure for Japan he was given the sum of \$483.36 from funds standing to his credit with the Custodian. This leaves a free balance in his account of \$33.02, being the net proceeds from sale of his radio.

No property interests other than those mentioned above are found on this file.

I have received a bill for \$4.00 for storage charges up till December 27 but under present circumstances I am unable to make the payment. ~~but will pay the same~~ will pay \$3.00 for up to November 27th. that means 3 months storage.

Nevertheless, I would wish to have your department transfer the above machine to your safe warehouse at 992 Powell Street, where the rest of my belongings are now stored and labelled Kenji Tatebe, #00001.
