PERSONAL PROPERTY SUMMARY

July 5, 1946.

Re: Kenichi TERASHITA, Registration No. 10766

This man signed a declaration to the Custodian on March 20, 1942. He was interned on May 16, 1942 and released on August 25, 1943.

In his declaration he reported a gasoline boat in custody at New Westminster. The records of the Japanese Fishing Vessels Disposal Committee show that this boat was sold to Nelson Bros. Fisheries Ltd. to whom TERASHITA owed \$303.42 and this was deducted from the selling price. On April 4, 1942 the sum of \$288.08 was paid to TERASHITA.

He reported a coho net left at Nelson Bros. Cannery. This net was bought by the cannery and \$40.00 was paid to TERASHITA on March 31, 1942.

He reported a \$1,000.00 policy with the Manufacturers Life Insurance Co. This did not come under the control of this office.

On September 4, 1943 this office forwarded to TERASHITA the sum of \$2.00 being refund of transportation from Nanaimo to Vancouver prior to his internment.

The account of this man was credited with the sum of \$10.35 received as refund of expenses incurred at the time of the impounding of his boat. This amount is being remitted to TERASHITA today.

Kenishi Terashita, 1207 Stewart Ave., Nanaimo, owner of the gill-net boat "RUTH" Naval #VO76H, powered by a 7 h.p. Vivian.

This boat was bought through the Japanese Vessel Disposal Committee here in Vancouver. The deal on this boat was consummated before the Government had taken over the Japanese vessels, however, to comply with the regulations, we put the sale through the Japanese Fishing Vessels Disposal Committee here in Vancouver and if any money was paid to Terashita, it was done on their authority.

We find on our file here that cheque #4849 was given to Terashita on April 1st for \$40.00 covering the sale to us of a gill net. This had been the usual practice with all the companies in the fishing business in the Rupert area of cleaning up Japanese nets stored in the different companies' net houses and owned by the Japanese fishermen who fished for the respective companies.

We trust this is the information you require.

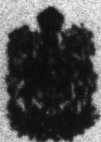
