Thank you for your letter of May 25th which, however, somewhat puzzles us as the following will show.

You declared to the Custodian on April 9th last year, household furniture etc. in your possession which you desired to sell, but failing which you would leave with those of your relatives. A report made by our investigator on May 28th showed nothing in the house at 2485 Powerline Road.

Your husband declared no property at all, and we are therefore at a loss to know where to look for the articles you request.

If, however, you can give further information on the application forms attached to our enclosed letter #107, the B. C. Security Commission will doubtless contact us and we will see what we can do to help them.

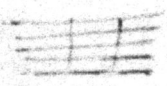
Dear Mr. Green
