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



The above Japanese when registering with this office on the 9th April, 1942, declared the following personal debts:-

I. SHOJIMA, Stillwater, B.C.	\$250.00
New Fish Market, Vancouver, B.C.	103.00
M. Furuya Co.	20.75

Of these only M. Furuya Company filed their claim of \$20.77.

In addition to these accounts Isamu UJIMOTO claimed the sum of \$14.28 owing him by SHOJIMA. This was admitted by SHOJIMA on the 7th August, 1943 and at his request UJIMOTO's address was given to him as he wished to pay the account direct. On the 28th January, 1947, we wrote to UJIMOTO asking if this account had been paid, and as no reply was received from him, it is assumed that SHOJIMA had made settlement of the account.

Masuke SHOJIMA returned to Japan on the 17th June, 1946, and the only funds which accrued to his credit were from chattels sold amounting to \$5.78, and this amount was transferred to M. Furuya Company in partial settlement of their claim, 21st April, 1947.




Mosuke SHOJIMA made his declaration to the Custodian on April 9th, 1942 and was evacuated on April 11th, 1942.

He declared certain tools, including a kit of carpenter's tools, which were left in care of H. Dean, Hanesy, B. C. These were checked and inventoried by our fieldmen on June 16th, 1942 and found to consist of 4 wedges, 2 sledge hammers, 3 cross cut saws, 1 axe and 1 peavy. The carpenter's tools were not found and this was noted at the time.

The tools listed above were sold at our Mission auctions of 17/3/45, 24/3/45, and 5/4/45 realizing the net sum of \$5.78, this sum being credited to the account of Mosuke SHOJIMA as per sales sheets on this file.
