SPECIFIED ARTICLES: A Victor radio was received from the R. C. M. P. and sold in our Vancouver Auction No. 21 for the net sum of \$85.04.


VICTORY BONDS: Declared one \$50.00 Victory bond in his own possession. This was not brought under control of the Custodian.

WAR SAVING CERTIFICATES: He declared five \$5.00 War Savings Certificates in his own possession. These were not brought under control of the Custodian.

LIFE INSURANCE: He declared a \$1,000.00 policy in the Sun Life Assurance Co. of Canada, the policy being in his own possession. On April 22, 1946, we received a letter from the Sun Life Assurance Co. together with a radio receipt which they had received from UYESUGI which would enable funds derived from sale of said radio to be applied to premium of Sun Policy No. 2203466.
