PERSONAL PROPERTY SUMMARY

This file reveals that Mrs. KONNO owned no real property in any protected area of B.C. and did not carry any Fire Insurance.

CHATELS: Mrs. KONNO, who made her declaration to the Custodian on April 9/42, declared chattels left at Steveston (no address, only P.O. box 64). As the Custodian did not find any chattels in the name of Mrs. KONNO, we wrote her on Sept. 5/44 and asked her to give us definite information as to where these had been left. We wrote again on Oct. 3/44. Receiving no reply to either of these letters we may assume that she took her chattels with her or disposed of them prior to her evacuation.

SPECIFIED ARTICLES: On Jan. 18/46 Mrs. KONNO wrote and requested shipment of her camera which had been surrendered to the R.C.M.P., enclosing fifty cents for packing and mailing charges. This camera was mailed to her on Feb. 4/46. Packing and mailing charges were only 21¢, so the balance of the 50¢ in the sum of 29¢ was credited to her account with this office.

The radio which she surrendered to the R.C.M.P. on March 17/42 was handed over by them to the Custodian on Dec. 17/43 and sold at auction for the net sum of \$17.44, and this sum credited to her account with the Custodian.

WAR SAVINGS CERTIFICATES: Mrs. KONNO declared the sum of \$30.00 in War Savings Certificates in her own possession. These were not brought under the control of the Custodian.

BANK ACCOUNT: Mrs. KONNO declared the sum of \$7.21 in the name of her child Meiko in the Japan and Canada Trust & Savings Co. and the sum of \$16.42 in the name of her husband with the same company. Neither the name of Meiko or Hideo KONNO appear on the list of names having accounts with this Company as of Dec. 31/42. It would therefore seem that these two accounts had been withdrawn prior to their evacuation.

LIFE INSURANCE: Mrs. KONNO declared an insurance policy with the Sun Life Assurance Co. in the sum of \$1000.00 in the name of her husband and a Twenty Year Endowment Policy in the sum of \$255.00 with the Prudential Insurance Co., in the name of her child Meiko. These were not brought under the control of the Custodian.

No property interests other than those mentioned above are found on this file.

IN THE MATTER OF a receipt for a radio owned by

present at Taber, Alta., housewife:

I, Michiko (Mrs. Hideo) KONNO, of Steveston, B.C., at present at Taber, Alta., house wife, do solemnly declare:

1. That I owned a Columbia combination radio, and have personal knowledge of the facts herein declared.
2. That I had in my possession and control at Steveston, B.C., a Columbia combination radio.
3. On the 17th day of March, 1942, I delivered the said radio to the Royal Canadian Mounted Police at Vancouver, B.C., but did not receive a receipt therefor.
4. That the sole reason for the non-production of the receipt is that I did not receive one from the Royal Canadian Mounted Police at the time I surrendered my radio.
5. That I have been informed that my radio has been sold at auction for the net sum of \$17.44, and this sum credited to my account with the Custodian.
6. That I, Michiko (Mrs. Hideo) KONNO, the owner, am therefore now entitled to the funds derived from sale of my radio.

AND I make this solemn declaration, conscientiously believing it to be true and knowing that it is of the same force and effect as if made under oath and by virtue of the Canada Evidence Act.
