CHATTEL SUMMARY

File 2333

April 23rd, 1946.

Re: Ichiro SHINO, Reg. 09155.

The above Japanese made his declaration to the Custodian on April 9th, 1942 and was evacuated on April 11th, 1942.

Mr. SHINO declared that he left his personal belongings, listed on the Chattel Schedule, at 233 Even Avenue. However, this property was owned by Shusai SASAKI, File 9963 and the building on it was demolished prior to December 1943 under orders of the City of New Westminster.


In June 1943 Reverend McWilliams picked up at 333 Even Avenue 26 gramophone records at the request of Ichiro SHINO and shipped them to him on June 9th, 1943.

As a result of inquiries in 1946 SHINO admitted that his possessions had been removed to 333 Even Avenue, (Y. KATAKAMI, File 3421). The Custodian had not been informed of this before. File 3421 does not reveal however, that KATAKAMI acknowledged any other person's effects left there except his own, and these he only declared in general terms. However, this file does reveal that as the result of our review of other Japanese files that several people declared their effects as being at 333 Even Avenue. Yaichi KATAKAMI on May 1st, 1945 supplied a detailed list of effects left at 333 Even Avenue but did not inform the Custodian whether any of these were the property of the other Japanese although he had been asked to do so.

In view of this, it can be assumed that SHINO and KATAKAMI had made mutual arrangements in regard to personal effects and the proceeds from the sale of effects may remain at the credit of Yaichi KATAKAMI.







PERSONAL PROPERTY SUMMARY

April 24th, 1946.

The above made his declaration to the Custodian on April 9th, 1942 and was evacuated on April 11th, 1942.

CHATELS:

This declarant states that he owned and left certain chattels at 233 1/2 Ewen Avenue, New Westminster. This file does not reveal any further evidence as to this however. The property was owned by Shusai SASAKI, File 5963 and it is revealed on that file that a building erected thereon was condemned on October 26th, 1942 and demolished. On February 14th, 1946 he admitted that his effects were removed by Yuichi KATAKAMI, to 333 Ewen Avenue but his effects could not be identified at that address.

SPECIFIED  
ARTICLES:

One 620 camera and case was handed over to the R. C. M. P. on May 9th, 1942. It has since been released and mailed to Ichiro SHINO on January 10th, 1946 and he acknowledged its receipt on January 26th, 1946.

WAR SAVINGS  
CERTIFICATES:

A \$100.00 Victory Bond and \$50.00 War Savings Certificates are in the owner's possession.

One \$5.00 Dominion of Canada War Savings Certificate was received from the Pacific Pine Company and was mailed to him on October 31st, 1944. This Company also refunded a payment of \$2.00 made by Ichiro SHINO on account of another certificate. This amount was placed to his credit.

ACCOUNTS  
RECEIVABLE:

SHINO had a savings deposit of \$450.00 in the Canadian Bank of Commerce, New Westminster. These did not come under the control of the Custodian.

No property interests other than those mentioned above are found on this file.

Dear Sir:

We have written to you on numerous occasions in regard to the personal effects removed from 333 Bevan Avenue and sold at auction. As there were three other persons besides yourself who declared they had left their effects at this address, it is not yet clear as to the ownership of these.

The storage at 333 Bevan Avenue appears to have been a last minute affair as in no case did any person give the Custodian a list of their possessions and this office was therefore, quite in the dark as to what they were or to whom the goods belonged. Consequently, when our fieldmen removed the saleable effects they simply took what they found, and as you have already been advised, credited the account of Yuichi KATAKAMI, the registered householder, with the sales proceeds.

We are sending a copy of this letter to all those persons interested and would suggest that the funds representing the proceeds from chattels auctioned be left in Mr. KATAKAMI'S account until you decide between yourselves as to its distribution. To this end will you kindly sign in the place indicated on the attached slip and return this slip if agreeable.
