Dear Madam:

Re: Estate of Hirohito TAKEDA, File 11923.

Your letter dated January 28, 1947 has been referred to Mr. J.H. Straight, Official Administrator and he has replied stating that the balance of your share, namely, \$162.32 will be sent to this office this month. This will be forwarded to you at once.

We presume that you understand that under Canadian law since your husband left no will, the estate is divided 1/3 to you and the rest equally among the children.

The entire share belonging to you as stated above will soon reach you and the shares of the children will be sent to each of them as soon as they reach the age of 21.

The Department of Labour records indicate that Eigi was born on January 16, 1922, and Shiro was born July 27, 1925, and both of these would appear to be old enough to receive their shares.

We would suggest that you have Eigi and Shiro write to Mr. J.H. Straight, Official Administrator, New Westminster, B.C. requesting their share of the funds. Mr. Straight will require to see their birth certificates if they have them, and if not no doubt these could be obtained from the Vital Statistics Branch, Provincial Government, Victoria, if they were born in the Province of British Columbia. Birth certificates may be obtained for the fee of \$1.00 each. This procedure may be followed by each of the other children as they reach the age of 21.
