While in the custody of the Royal Canadian Navy, this vessel suffered loss to the value of \$29.00, as assessed by the surveyor for Naval Service, which sum is approved by the undersigned and accepted as adequate compensation. Your account was also credited with the sum of \$3.90, being a refund of 15 wage deductions for 1941.

The sum of \$200.00 was remitted to you on October 22nd, 1945, and \$100.00 on October 1st, 1945.
