Dear Sir:

In response to your letter of November 17, I have no personal property left at 512 Alexander Street, Vancouver, B. C. At the time of my evacuation I was able to bring all of my personal property.

Thank you for writing to me about this matter.

Mr. Heishiro Aoyama Reg. No. 01218, who had been living with me until April 7, 1942, left some of his personal property in my care, which at the time of my evacuation I asked the Custodian to have it stored in my name. I received a letter, File No. 1233, from Mr. Aoyama recently, with an enclosure-- a form for him to sign if he had no property in any protected area of British Columbia--but as he had some personal effects in the protected area in the hand of the Custodian, I wrote you in answer to this question. No doubt, the letter is in your hand by now. If you will refer to File No. 1233, I know you will understand the situation.

I sincerely hope this letter will be helpful to you.
