

The above, on his J.P. form dated April 9th, 1942, declared "Personal effects in own possession at 148 East Columbia Street, New Westminster".


On February 22, 1944, Mr. TERAKAWA wrote and asked us to ship his violin and case which he had stored at the home of Mr. K. OKIHIRO, 148 East Columbia Street, New Westminster. A violin had been moved from this address to storage in the Buddhist Temple and we therefore assumed this was his violin and shipped it to him on March 23rd, 1944. He wrote several letters advising us that this was not his violin and finally gave us a better description of the instrument mentioning that the initials "M.K." would be found on the scroll. This description enabled us to identify it conclusively and the correct instrument was shipped to him on April 30th, 1945. He returned the first violin to us which was received in this office on October 3rd, 1945.

No other chattels were subsequently declared or requested by him.

Dear Sir:

Your file has now come under review, and the following is noted.

On April 9th, 1945, you declared that your personal effects were in your own possession at 148 East Columbia Street, New Westminster, and as no chattels identified as yours were found at the time the chattels were removed from this address, we assume they were taken with you.

On February 22nd, 1944, you wrote and asked us to ship your violin and case which were stored at the home of Mr. K. Okihiro, 148 East Columbia Street, New Westminster. A violin had been moved from this address to storage in the Buddhist Temple and we therefore assumed this was yours and shipped it to you accordingly. You advised us that this instrument was not yours and gave us further particulars about your violin which enabled us to identify it. Your own violin was shipped to you on April 30th, 1945, and we received from you on October 3rd, the one we had shipped you in error.

You declared a policy with the Sun Life Assurance Company in the amount of \$1500.00 in your own possession. This did not come under the control of the Custodian.

The Balda camera which the Royal Canadian Mounted Police reported was surrendered by you, was released to the B. C. Security Commission on December 30th, 1945, for shipment to you.

It would appear that we have accounted for all the property of every kind left by you in the protected area which vested in the Custodian and in order that you may confirm this, we are enclosing a stamped, addressed envelope for convenience in replying.
