GENERAL SUMMARY

The above-mentioned Japanese was interned on September 11th 1942, P.W.A. No. 730, and he was released from internment April 19th 1943.

Chattels: Declared in 'JP' Form dated September 9th 1942:

"1 suitcase clothing

1 clothes bag"

No mention is made on file regarding these effects, however, if same were left at his former address 129-10th Street, New Westminster, B. C. they have been sold and proceeds credited to his father's account No. 3344 as Tomokichi OHASHI was the registered owner of this property and declared the personal effects belonged to him. However it is more than likely that these articles were taken away with the Japanese as he declared having a suitcase in Taft, B. C.

Life Insurance: Declared in 'JP' Form dated April 9th 1942:

"1000.00 Prudential Life Assurance Co., Vancouver, B. C.
Policy No. 112414466 - Beneficiary father (Tamikichi)"

No mention is made on file regarding this policy and Prudential Life Company advised on August 28th 1946 that they had no record of this policy.

"\$1000.00 Confederation Life Assurance Co., Vancouver, B.C.
Policy No. X-558318 - Beneficiary father (Tamakichi)
Premiums paid to date, in possession of father. At 129 W.
10th St. New Westminster, B. C."

Confederation Life Association advised the Custodian Office on November 28th 1942 that the premium under this policy was due on July 28th 1942, and according to their records a payment of only \$5.00 was made and the policy lapsed on August 28th/42.

Policy is filed in the insurance cabinet in our Office.

Claims: Declared in statement of assets and liabilities sent to us by the internment camp "Sept. 42 back wages at TAFT, B.C. about \$4.00, Dept. of Mine & Resources."

October 19th 1942, Department of Mines and Resources forwarded their cheque in the amount of \$4.00 to be credited to the account of Haruo OHASHI.

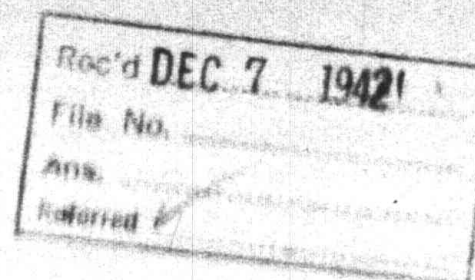

Your letter of the 27th of November with reference to the above internee has been forwarded to us by our Vancouver office and we are enclosing form "D" as requested. This is our first advice that this party has been interned.

The third paragraph of your letter suggests something quite new since we did not know of any arrangement whereby insurance policies would be maintained in force on the lives of internees.

In the above case the policy was issued in November 1941 and at that time the insured paid a broken-period premium to cover from November to July, and future premiums, amounting to \$28.11, would fall due annually in July. Within the days of grace of the July premium the insured made a payment of \$5.00 on account but no further payment was made. The policy, therefor, lapsed on the 28th of August 1942. The policy can be placed regularly in force again only by the submission of satisfactory evidence of insurability in addition to payment of outstanding premiums.

This policy was issued on November 13th, 1941 and a broken period premium from November 13th, 1941 to July 28th, 1942 of \$19.80 was paid. \$5.00 was paid on August 21st, 1942 on account of the premium due July 28th, 1942. The policy accordingly lapsed through non-payment for the balance of the premium.

Will you be kind enough to parade this internee and ask him if he knows these men and if they are still in Canada or, in the event that they have returned to Japan, the approximate date of their departure from Canada. If, in addition, he knows the addresses of them, either in Canada or Japan, the information would be much appreciated.


