Dear Sir:

We enclose herewith Custodian cheque in the sum of \$79.32.
As this is your total credit with the Custodian we are now closing your file.

We have reviewed your file and we note that the furniture and household goods belonging to you were first left with the tenant of 620 Sealin Drive. In February of 1944 you requested shipment of the major portion of these chattels and same were shipped to you on February 22nd, 1944. Some of the goods were left with Mr. Skodje at your request, and the balance were removed to our warehouse and sold at auction for the net sum of \$73.15 and this sum was credited to your account with this office.

Your radio was sold at auction for the net sum of \$56.08 and this sum was also credited to your account with this office.

After shipment of your furniture the insurance carried on same was cancelled and your account has been credited with the sum of \$.29, being a return premium on this cancelled policy.

At your request your camera was mailed to you on October 15th, 1945, and the mailing charges in the sum of \$.20 were deducted from your credit balance with this office.

You declared a bank account in the Bank of Montreal and three life insurance policies. None of these were brought under the control of the Custodian.

It would appear that we have accounted for all the property of every kind left by you in the protected area which vested in the Custodian, and in order that you may confirm this and acknowledge the cheque, we are enclosing a stamped addressed envelope for convenience in replying.
