LIABILITY SUMMARYRe: ASAHINA, Jenichi - Reg. No. 02602.

Claims filed against Jenichi ASAHINA are as follows:

Komura Bros. \$17.27.

This claim ASAHINA stated that he had paid. We advised Komura Bros. of this and, in the absence of any comments on their part, we presume that the claim was paid.

Vancouver General Hospital.....\$2.50

The debtor states the claim has been paid while the Hospital states to the contrary. The Hospital have been given ASAHINA's address so that they might settle directly and then advise us. No word has been received from them since and we assume that the claim is still unsettled.
Debtor agrees to pay - 22/1/47.

Dr. M. UCHIDA\$19.00

This claim was admitted by the debtor who, however, stated that he was unable to settle. Since, all claim filed by Dr. UCHIDA have been withdrawn.

Provincial Board of Health\$408.00

The debtor admitted this claim but was unable to pay. The Collector of Institutional Revenue informed us that, when the Japanese debtor's credit balance was small, they were not interested in receiving small payments. No further action, therefore, is being taken.

PERSONAL PROPERTY SUMMARYRe: ASAHINA, Jenichi - Reg. No. 02602.

The above signed a declaration to the Custodian on April 9, 1942 and was evacuated on July 10, 1942.

CHATELS: He declared the following at 406 Alexander Street:

The property was owned by Shinsaburo KAWADE, Dec'd, father of Shinichi KAWADE, and was sold in the Spring of 1942. The business, a rooming house, was sold in May 1942. There is no record of chattels being moved from that address except a few cartons marked Y. F. Fujioka, File 11932 being identified as the owner.

In view of the fact that the property was sold several months before ASAHINA was evacuated, we can only presume that he disposed of his chattels at the time of the sale.

ASAHINA called 29/1/47 - did not mention chattels.

SPECIFIEDARTICLES:

He owned a radio - R. C. A. Victor Mantel which was sold by Auction for the net sum of \$39.39. *Receipt - on file - 29/1/47.*

BONDS:

He also declared \$5.00 of War Savings Certificates belonging to his daughter Namiyo, these being in his own possession. They were not brought under the control of the Custodian.

Re: Your File No. 2381. Letter dated 11th, Feb.

Please excuse me for delay to answer to your letter of the 11th February.

With reference to my debts which you asked me for dispositions, permit me to state the following circumstances for your consideration.

Regarding my account with KOMURA BROS. LTD. amounting \$17.27 and \$2.50 owing to Vancouver General Hospital, I beg to inform you that the both of these accounts had been paid in full before I removed from the coast. I regret that I cannot attach the receipts, to prove the fact. Because of the fact that much confusion brewed at the time of Evacuation, I could not mind over to keep the receipts for future references.

The account \$19.00 owing to doctor M. Uchida, I am quite responsible for this account, however, I am not able to settle this at present, as I am at present in a position supporting my family's livings under the government relief.

The account \$408.00 owing to the Provincial Board of Health, I beg to state that I was suffering from T.B. and was so destitute, not being able to pay for any bill at that time. Under this circumstance, I have made application to the Provincial Board of Health, through doctor M. Uchida, for the expenses covering the treatment of my ailment and the case was fully approved by the Board. However, I am intending to dispose this account gradually when I am in a position, capable in doing so.
