
Please note that the above Japanese has been repatriated to Japan. The following is the status of his account with this Department, covering the repatriation transactions:

PERSONAL PROPERTY SUMMARY

CHATELS: The above, who made his declaration to the Custodian on April 9th, 1942, and was evacuated on June 5th, 1942, declared a motor boat in custody at Prince Rupert and 2 sets of fishing nets left in the cannery house at Mill Bay in care of the B.C. Packers.
The account on file from the B.C. Packers Ltd. at Mill Bay shows that they have credited TATEISHI with the sum of \$25.00 for one Cohoe net and \$15.00 for one spring net. This credit plus a credit of \$4.50 for hanging net and \$140.17 for fish, is deducted from his bill owing to them in the amount of \$314.54, leaving a debit of \$129.87 owing by TATEISHI to the B.C. Packers Ltd. This account is being paid from his credit balance with this office as per request contained in his letter of Feb. 5/46.

SPECIFIED ARTICLES: The file reveals that the above was the registered owner of a fishing vessel the "NACHI #1". This vessel was sold through the office of the Custodian on October 24th, 1942, for the net sum of \$151.23, and this amount credited to his account with this office. Full details of this are given on Specified Articles summary on file.

The sum of \$151.23 represents his entire credit balance with this office. After the account of \$129.87 mentioned above has been paid, there will be a credit balance of \$21.36 standing in his account.

No property interests other than those mentioned above are found on this file.

Your file has been reviewed and the following is noted.

In your declaration to the Custodian made on April 9th, 1942, you declared a motor boat in custody at Prince Rupert, and two sets of fishing nets left in the Cannery house at Mill Bay, B.C., in care of the B.C. Packers Ltd.

A statement of account between you and the B.C. Packers Ltd. was sent to this office on October 15th, 1942. This account shows a credit to you in the sum of \$40.00 for your two nets left with them. Their account still showed a balance of \$129.87 owing to them. We sent you a copy of this account on January 2nd, 1946, and you replied to this letter on February 5th asking us to pay this account from your credit balance with this office. This request has been complied with, a cheque for \$129.87 being remitted to the B. C. Packers Ltd. on the 11th instant.

The fishing vessel you declared, the "Nachi #1", was sold through the office of the Custodian for the net sum of \$151.23, and this amount credited to your account with this office.

After deducting the amount of the cheque sent to the B.C. Packers Ltd. from your credit balance of \$151.23, there now remains to your credit with this office the sum of \$21.36.

It would appear that we have accounted for all the property of every kind left by you in the protected area which vested in the Custodian, and in order that you may confirm this, we are enclosing a stamped addressed envelope for convenience in replying.
