
Please note that the above Japanese has been repatriated to Japan. The following is the status of his account with this Department, covering the repatriation transactions:

This man signed a declaration to the Custodian on April 9, 1942. He was evacuated on April 11, 1942.

In his declaration he reported a boat in custody of the R.C.M.P. Our records show that this boat was sold by the Custodian and the net proceeds in the amount of \$237.71 were credited to this man's account. We re-mitted this money to KATAYAMA on August 11, 1943 and March 2, 1945.

In reply to your letter of July 26th, we wish to advise that the fishing vessel "Sumire" was sold for the sum of \$275.00, which was the value placed on her by an independent and experienced marine surveyor.

No commissions or administration costs are charged in connection with these vessels. The only charges made are to cover such expenses as, fire insurance, wharfage, wages of watchmen, survey (for purpose of valuation), etc. These expenses in the case of the "Sumire" amounted to \$37.29.

The balance of \$237.71 has been placed to your credit in our trust account.
