

Gentlemen: -

Re: Hishakichi Nishi - Your File 2393.

Replying to your inquiry of the loth inst. I wish to advise that we have no vessels listed at this port under the name "Midori". However, not all the vessels recorded here were named at the time the applications were filed, hence I have no record of the names of some of them.

License No. 1337 of this port was issued to I. Yoshida in 1922. I regret that I cannot send you a copy of this application, as same appears to have been lost. However, the particulars of the boat as they appear in my book are as follows: - Length, 32 feet; Breadth, 7 feet; Depth, 3 feet, 4 inches; tons 3.

Hisakichi Nishi is listed here as owner of the gasboat "Hanaini", which was licensed in his name in 1929, with no subsequent transactions recorded. I am sending you a copy of the "Form B" for this boat in case it may be of some help to you. This boat bears our License No. 1785.

In addition we have License No. 1994 in the name of Hikejiro Nishi for a 30-feet boat, and No. 2423 in the name of H. Nishi for a 30-foot boat, but there is no resemblance between the signatures on these and that on No. 1785.

If I can help in any other way, please advise me.
