
Kichiji URUSHIHARA died at Slocan on September 12, 1943. He is survived by his widow, Hatsue, file #7230, who has now been repatriated to Japan. He had no children.

The only assets declared by the deceased were a 22 foot gas boat and 200 fathoms of sockeye net which he valued at \$20.00. The boat was sold for the sum of \$50.00 and the proceeds credited to the account of the deceased. The net was not found and was probably valueless.

The only claim filed against the deceased was for the sum of \$80.00 to cover funeral expenses paid by the B. C. Security Commission. On March 13, 1945, Custodian cheque for \$50.00, being total funds to the credit of the deceased, was forwarded to the B. C. Security Commission to apply on their claim. The widow was advised of the disposition of her husband's assets.

No assets and no liabilities, other than those mentioned above, appear on this file.

Dear Madam:-

On going through your deceased husband's file, the only assets we can trace are a fishing vessel sold for \$50.00 and a net left at Rivers Inlet valued at \$20.00. We have no record of the net and feel that it would by now, in any case, be valueless.

Under these circumstances, we have paid the \$50.00 proceeds on the sale of the boat to the B. C. Security Commission against their claim of \$80.00 for funeral expenses.
