Replying to copy of your letter of March 11th, addressed to the Custodian of Alien Property, re goods belonging to the above we have located these articles stored in a cupboard at 718 Fraser Street.

These boxes are closely packed together. We were accompanied by an official of Lindsay's Cartage; he hauled out the front row but time did not permit nor was it feasible to pull out everything and put it back again. He gave a rough estimate of ~~500~~ pounds weight, and computed the shipping charges to Vancouver at around \$4.50. Lindsay's charges for cartage and some re-erating (many of the boxes are flimsy cartons) at \$3.50. Our charges for our services in connection with this matter will be \$2.00. If you desire them shipped let us know at once and we will arrange it, possibly at the time of shipping the Miwa goods.

The electric sewing-machine was in the cupboard and will need erating.
