GENERAL SUMMARY

August 13, 1946.

Re: Yoshiji NOBUOKA, Reg. No. 07382

This man signed a declaration to the Custodian on April 9, 1942. He was evacuated on August 4, 1942.

In his declaration he reported \$80.00 in War Savings Certificates and a \$5,000.00 policy with the Manufacturers Life Insce. Co., both held in his father's safety deposit box. These were removed from the box and sent to NOBUOKA on November 2, 1943.

The records of the Japanese Fishing Vessels Disposal Committee show that this man was the owner of a vessel "Lake Biwa #11" which was sold and the net proceeds of \$2,970.00 were paid to NOBUOKA on February 23, 1942.
