#### PERSONAL PROPERTY SUMMARY

### Re: SOGA, Zenbel - Reg. No. 08257.

The above signed a declaration to the Custodian on March 18, 1942 and was evacuated on March 29, 1942.

CHATTELS: He declared a quantity of household goods which were also declared by his wife, Hana, File 11166. She was evacuated on September 9, 1942.

On October 29, 1942, we wrote to Zenbei and his wife that no chattels could be found at 381 Powell Street and that unless we heard from them to the contrary, we would presume that they had disposed of their chattels. Several more letters were written but no reply was received and it was therefore assumed that no chattels remained.

However, on May 4, 1945, SOGA stated as follows to the B. C. Security Commission in connection with a claim for rent: "Mr. Jameson (the landlord) was quite agreeable during evacuation time, that the rent would not be charged provided Mr. Soga left his furniture in his care which he claims was left at the premises and if and when these furniture can be produced to him by Mr. Jameson, then he is prepared by pay the rent mentioned above".

Upon telephoning Mr. Jameson on June 27,1947, he said that no furniture was found in the building after Mr. Soga vacated. He said he had charged the rent up to profit and loss, and said to forget about it.

SPECIFIED Motor Vehicles:

ARTICLES: SOGA, Zenbei owned a Chrysler Sedan which was released to Independent Motors on May 21, 1942. The lien amounted to \$144.00 A 1931 Independent Truck was sold for \$75.00, leaving a net \$47.79 which is credited to this account.

A Columbia Console belonging to SOGA was sold by auction for the sum of \$21.80 net. A declaration as to loss of receipt is on file.

### Re: SOGA, Zembet - 181 Powell Street.

While reviewing the file of Mr. SOGA we note that on July 8, 1942 you filed a claim of \$90.00 against him. This was in connection with the rent of 381 Powell St. for the months of April, May, June and July 1942.

We submitted your claim to Mr. SOGA who did not, at first, reply to our letters, but, later, through the Department of Labour stated as follows:

"Mr. Jameson was quite agreeable during evacuation time, that the rent would not be charged provided Mr. Soga left his furniture in his care which he claims was left at the premises and if and when these furnitures can be produced to him by Mr. Jameson, then he is prepared to pay the rent mentioned above."

Mr. and Mrs. SOGA both declared having left at 381 Powell St. a fairly large quantity of chattels which they valued at considerably over \$90.00. We presume that you removed these as our investigators who called at that address found nothing belonging to the Japanese.

We would appreciate it if you would kindly let us have your comments in this regard as soon as possible.
