This 27-year old Canadian-born Millhand, from Ocean Falls, B. C., signed a Custodian "JP" declaration form on the 9th April, 1942. He was not married at time of evacuation (Apr. 21/42).

Bank Accounts: None.


Life Insurance: A Prudential Life Insurance policy for \$1000.00 declared to be in owner's possession, did not come under the administration of this office.

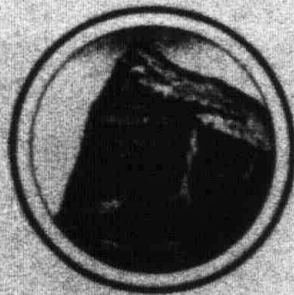
We are in receipt of and thank you for your letter of the 10th instant on the subject of a policy loan to the above evacuee, holder of your policy No. 7,201,700.


