This Japanese signed our "J" card indicating that he left no property whatsoever in the Protected Area..

Two cameras were surrendered to the R.C.M.P. and these were released to the B.C. Security Commission on May 4, 1943.

The fishing vessel "Golden Hind" belonging to the above Japanese was sold on April 20, 1942 and funds paid to G. Uyeda, April 23, 1942.

No liabilities.

No indication of any other personal property belonging to the above Japanese on file.

File indicates that he had a Life Insurance Policy in Manufacturers Life Ins. Co. This did not come under the control of the Custodian at any time.
