Your letter of the 14th instant regarding the above has just come to hand and we hasten to give you the information you require as to the financial standing of this Japanese.

He has no account with the Custodian, and according to our records lived in two rooms at 476 Alexander Street, paying a rental of \$10.00 per month. He has some chattels stored at Bowmans Storage Company Limited, but these do not appear to be of much value.

According to his "JP" form, dated April 9th, 1942, he had no real property and the only other item of note in his Declaration is that he owned one Dominion of Canada Victory Bond, valued at \$50.00, which he stated was left at his home in Alexander Street, Vancouver.

We observe that there is reference on our files to a "London Hotel (in wife's name)". We are investigating this and will report to you at the earliest possible.
