This vessel was released to the licensed owners, B. C. Packers Ltd. on May 21, 1942. As the above Evacuee did not declare the vessel, it is assumed that he had no interest in the boat.

The sum of \$5.00 was paid to the Custodian's office and credited to the account of the above Evacuee by the Dominion Government in settlement of the Evacuee's claim for a refund of expenses incurred in delivering the vessel, "Rose B." to Naval Service at Prince Rupert in December, 1941.
