We wish to acknowledge your letter of 13rd February.

Your request for the \$58.17 received from the sale of your son's radios has been referred to the Department of Labour, Japanese Division, who advise as follows:

"As the above named woman is in receipt of a Workmen's Compensation pension each month and her daughter is steadily employed by this Department in Lemon Creek, they are not in need of funds."

We are, therefore, unable to comply with your request.

With regard to the Internee's camera, we will forward this to you upon receipt of the original R.C.M.P. receipt and 10¢ postage to cover mailing charges.

Please also be good enough to let us have the R.C.M.P. receipts for the radios mentioned above, in order that funds may be free for release to the Internee.
