PERSONAL PROPERTY SUMMARY

The above was a student of 17 at the time she made her declaration to the Custodian on April 4/42. She declared no property of any kind whatsoever in the protected area of British Columbia.

However on March 15/44, the Mother Superior of the Catholic Mission at Greenwood gave us a list of those who had left beds at the Catholic Mission at Steveston, and among this list was the name of Shizue NISHIMURA. When these beds were removed from this mission, one was found tagged with the name "S. NISHIMURA". It was in reply to our query as to what this initial stood for that we received the reply from the Mother Superior giving us the full names of all those who had left beds at the mission. This bed was sold at Steveston auction on Feb. 18/44 for the net sum of \$6.38, which amount was credited to the account of the above.

The file reveals that the above owned no specified articles.

No property interests other than those mentioned above are found on this file.
