LIABILITY SUMMARY

In 1941, Satou YAMAKI filed a claim against Seichi NAKANO. For some unknown reason the Custodian on Feb. 4/43 sent a form letter #96 to the above, advising that YAMAKI had lodged a claim against him in the sum of \$50.00. He denied owing this money in his letter of Feb. 9/43, and YAMAKI was advised of this in our letter of Feb. 13/43. As he did not reply to this no further action was taken. (Our files have no Seichi NAKANO listed).

On Oct. 25/41 a claim of \$350.00 was filed against the above by Nelson Bros. Fisheries Ltd. In his letter of Nov., 1943, the above denied owing any money to this company. Further investigations were made and the file reveals that Yasuo NAKANO, a son of the above, File Int. 852, admitted owing this money to Nelson Bros. in his letter of Jan. 19/44. The file of the above is therefore free of all claims.

PERSONAL PROPERTY SUMMARY

The file reveals that the above owned no real property and that he carried no Fire Insurance.

CHATELS: The above, who made his declaration to the Custodian on April 4/42, signed a yellow "No property" card stating that he owned no property of any kind whatsoever in any protected area of British Columbia. Nevertheless we received the sum of \$187.78 from the Phoenix Cannery of the A.B.C. Packing Co., being the proceeds from sale of fishing gear. The account of the above was credited with this sum although he had worked for the Imperial Cannery. As there are two men with the name "K. NAKANO" on our files, we wrote to our Steveston agent, Mr. C.C. Robinson on Nov. 28/42 to find out which one of these men should be credited with this money. He advised on Jan. 20/43 that the money should be credited to the account of Kasuo NAKANO, File 4346, so this money was transferred to his account.

On Feb. 4/44 chattels were sold at Steveston auction #5 for the net sum of \$7.59 in the name of the above and this sum credited to his account. However as his wife had declared household goods and he had declared none, the money was transferred on July 8/46 from his account to her account, File No. 4892.

SPECIFIED ARTICLES: According to information supplied to this office the above was the registered owner of a fishing vessel the "ELSIE W", which was sold through the Japanese Fishing Vessel Disposal Committee for the net sum of \$1,777.00, and this sum was paid by the JFVDC to the Custodian and credited to the account of the above with this office. Full details are given on Specified Articles Summary on file.

MONEYS RECEIVABLE: In July, 1945, the account of the above was credited with the sum of \$1.22, being a refund of security deposit for light from the B.C.E.R.

No property interests other than those mentioned above are found on this file.

Additional Information: Nelson Bros. Fisheries Ltd. filed a claim for \$350.00 against this vessel. This money, however, appears to have been advanced to Yasuzo NAKANO, Internee File 852, son of Kiichi NAKANO. Yasuzo Nakano has acknowledged this debt. Nelson Bros. Fisheries Ltd. claim that the money was advanced on the understanding that the man to whom the advance was made was the owner of the "Elsie N". This vessel was licenced in the name of Kiichi NAKANO.
