

The position here is that Chojiro Sumida file 2502, and his wife, file 12709, together with Mrs. Takeno Ono, file 12707 (now deceased), owned jointly a barber shop and some personal effects at 75 W. Cordova. Chojiro SUMIDA was evacuated on March 29th, 1942, and on October 14th, 1942 the remaining partners declared on file 12709 that all their property in the protected area had been disposed of. These files may now, therefore, be closed but file 12707, ~~being an estate, is being sent to~~ Mr. Johnston for his consideration.

Please accept our thanks for your report of October 15 in which you advised us that this barber equipment has been sold for \$100.00 to Mr. Hugh Allen and that the Japanese concerned have already disposed of the money received.

We note that Chojiro Sumida, our File No. 2502, and his wife, Mrs. Hakaru Sumida, our File No. 12709, each claim one-half interest in this barber equipment with Mrs. Takeno Ono, our File No. 12707. We are presuming that Mrs. Ono owns a one-half interest and that the other half is owned jointly by Mr. and Mrs. Sumida.

LOCATION AND NATURE OF PROPERTY

LOCATION AND NATURE OF BUSINESS

This man was evacuated on March 29th, 1942. He was carrying on the business of a Barber at 75 West Cordova Street, in partnership with his wife, H. Sumida and another woman, T. Ono and all were living in the back of the premises in which the barber shop was conducted. All barber equipment and personal effects, as shown in the inventory attached hereto, are the joint property of Chojiro Sumida, H. Sumida and T. Ono. The inventory has been checked and is correct in detail, but the prices given are excessive. In a sale, the inventory would not produce any more than one-half of the figures given. On evacuation, it is the wish of H. Sumida and T. Ono, to store all of the above equipment and effects, with the exception of one trunk containing personal goods and one Sewing Machine, which they hope to take with them.

RECOMMENDATION

I would recommend that on evacuation of H. Sumida and T. Ono, their wishes be followed and that the barber shop equipment and personal effects, other than what is taken with them, be stored for the duration.
