PERSONAL PROPERTY SUMMARY

January 19, 1946.

This man was evacuated on May 11, 1942. On March 24, 1942 he signed a declaration to the Custodian stating that he owned one \$50.00 Victory Bond and \$50.00 in War Savings Certificates which were in his own possession at that time. These did not come under the control of the Custodian.

On August 14, 1942 a cheque for \$380.00 was received from J.S. Greer of Prince Rupert. This sum was the balance due SUYEHIO from the sale price of an engine sold on his behalf by Mr. Greer for the sum of \$500.00 after the deduction of \$125.00 due Mr. Greer from SUYEHIO.

On October 9, 1942 and November 23, 1942, remittances totalling \$150.00 were made to SUYEHIO. In August 1943, \$25.00 was remitted to his wife. In September 1943, \$5.45 was paid to the B.C. Security Commission and in October 1942, we paid at his request a claim filed against him, of \$18.00. This leaves a credit balance in his account at this date of \$181.55. *For*

Dear Sir:

As requested by you, we enclose Custodian cheque for the sum of \$161.55, representing all the funds standing to your credit with this office.

Your account was credited with the sum of \$380.00 on August 14, 1942. This money was received from Mr. J. S. Greer, Prince Rupert, and was the amount due you from the sale of an engine for \$500.00, after the deduction by Mr. Greer of a balance of \$120.00 which you owed him.

In October, 1942, at your request, we paid the claim of \$18.00 filed against you by J. H. Todd & Sons Ltd.

Remittances totalling \$150.00 were made to you in October and November, 1942, and in August, 1943, at your request we remitted the sum of \$25.00 to your wife. In September, 1943, the sum of \$5.45 was paid to the B. C. Security Commission to cover the cost of a shipment of effects sent to your wife.

In your declaration to the Custodian, March 24, 1942, you stated that you were the owner of a Victory Bond and some War Savings Certificates. These did not come under the control of this office.

It would appear that we have accounted for all the property of every kind left by you in the protected area which vested in the Custodian and, in order that you may confirm this and acknowledge the cheque, we enclose a stamped, addressed envelope for your convenience in replying.
