

This file reveals that SUZUKI owned no real property in any protected area of B.C. and did not carry any Fire Insurance.

CHATTELS:

SUZUKI made his declaration to the Gustodian on Mar. 20/42 and was evacuated on Mar. 21/42. "e declared chattels as shown on Chattel Schedule on file, at Third Lake, Stillwater. No chattels were recovered from this place as it was very inaccessible. Mr. McNair, of the McNair Shingle Co., advised that no one could remove any of these chattels without his knowledge as they had to use his boats to cross the lake. However we were informed tools, etc. were stolen. Our agent, Mr. Logan visited the place in June, 1942, and gave a full report on the matter. This is contained in Mr. Green's memo of April 30/43 on file.

MONEYS RECEIVABLE:

SUZUKI was a sub contractor for the EBISUZAKI CO. He declared they owed him \$150.00 for salary for February and one half of March, 1942. However he filed a large claim of \$610.02 with P. S. noss & Sons who were handling this company. According to P.S.noss and Sons part of this money was salary owing to other employees who had been working under SUZUKI and not money owing to SUZUKI. We wrote and maked SUZUKI for a full statement of what he owed other employees of the EBISUZAKI CO. and what the company owed him. He wrote on June 16/45 and his reply was as follows:

"I didn't get the wages for 18 full months.

On June 25/43 the account of SUZUKI was credited with the Jun of \$200.00, being a 20% dividend of claims of the EBISUZAKI CO.

On Sept. 27/43 his account was credited with the sum of \$300.00, being a 30% dividend of claims of the EBISUZAKI CO.

On Aug. 15/44, at the request of SUZUKI we paid automatic premium loan and interest on his policy #607588 with the Sun Life Co. in the sum of \$466.10, leaving a balance of \$33.90 in his account. At this time it was apparently thought that all the funds credited to his account belonged to him. This was apparently in error and the balance remaining has been held pending clarifaction of his account with the EBISUZAKI CO.

On Aug. 3/46 a further dividend of 5% was received from the EBISUZAKI Co. in the sum of \$50.00 and this amount credited to the account of SUZUKI. A further dividend of \$447.48 was received in Aug. 1946 and this sum credited to his account. His balance is now \$531.38.

INCOME TAX:

He has applied for a refund of Dominion income tax in the sum of \$88.95. This has not yet been received from the Inspector of Income Tax.

LIFE INSURANCE: He has declared a life insurance policy of \$1000.00 with the Sun Life Assurance Co. As mentioned previously we paid automatic premium loan and interest on this policy #807588 in the sum of \$466.10 from his credit with this office. The cash surrender value of this policy amounting to \$836.97 was received and remitted to SUZUKI on Jan. 3/46

No property interest other than those mentioned above are found on this file.

The above summary is certified to be in accordance with the information file.

"The two camps, Tairs and Susuki, are reached from Stillwater as follows: 4 miles by car 9 miles by boat i mile on foot 44 miles by boat 4 miles on foot Total of 22 miles

Mr. Logen visted this place in June/42 and checked all the equipment to be found in the two camp bunk houses. It was quite impossible to decide which tools belonged to which man. Also there are tools left in the bush which can only be located by the dapanese themselves."

He also states that it would cost more than the value of the tools to have them moved. Tools were also stolen so it would be impossible to say what goods were still there.

The following is an extract from Mr. McNair's letter of July 21/43:

I cannot ship you any of the enclosed articles as they are away back in the woods, and as the camp is shut down there is no way to take this stuff out only by packing it on your back, and it is impossible to get anybody to do that

We have your letter of the 18th addressed to us at Stillwater, B.C. with regard to certain goods belonging to the above. The house in which these items were stored is located four miles in the woods, and we cannot tell you whether or not the things in question would be still there. Believe some of the buildings in that particular area had fallen in on account of heavy snowfalls. This matter we reported to the Custodian on May 13, 1943 when an inspection of the camp was made. Since that time, however, our logging camp has not been operating and consequently we have had no occasion to go up there.
