This man signed a declaration to the Custodian on March 25, 1942.

In his declaration he reported a C.C.M. bicycle and a list of chattels belonging to his parents, all stored at Union College, U.B.C., Vancouver. On April 9, 1942 he wrote from Toronto that he had taken all these items with him on his evacuation.

He reported a 1941 Chevrolet sedan turned in at Hastings Park. This car was registered in the name of "Togo Cleaners" and when it was sold the net proceeds of \$873.02 were credited to the account of Kosaburo TAKAHASHI, File No. 645, principal shareholder of "Togo Cleaners" and father of this man.
