

Dear Sir:

Enclosed herewith is Custodian cheque for the sum of \$50.25, representing all the funds standing to your credit with this office. These funds were received in full settlement of the claim filed by your father with the Japanese Fishing Vessels Disposal Committee for refund of expenses incurred at the time of the impounding of the vessel "S.T." These funds were transferred to your account from the account of your father on instructions received from him on February 14, 1946.

On November 11, 1943, we sent to you the Manufacturers Life Insurance Co. cheque for \$54.96, in payment of the cash surrender value of your policy.

The War Savings Certificates which you reported to this office did not come under the control of the Custodian.

It would appear that we have accounted for all the property of every kind left by you in the protected area which vested in the Custodian and in order that you may confirm this and acknowledge the cheque, we enclose a stamped addressed envelope for your convenience in replying.

LIABILITY SUMMARY

Re: Sadao TAKAMATSU, Reg. No. 09224

This file reveals that a claim for \$12.00 was registered by Dr. C. H. HANKINSON against Sadao TAKAMATSU. As this man was not of age at the time this debt was incurred the claim was referred to his father who informed us that when he had paid Dr. HANKINSON for treatment to his sons about seventeen or eighteen years before 1944, he had been about \$30.00 short in his payment of the doctor's bill of \$150.00, and the doctor had stated that he would cancel the unpaid amount of the bill. TAKAMATSU, however, had no proof of this. However, as Dr. HANKINSON has not denied TAKAMATSU's statement about the age of this indebtedness we took it that TAKAMATSU's statement is correct. If this is the case this debt would be outlawed by the Statute of Limitations; and no further action has been taken in regard to this.

This file reveals no other liabilities.

This man signed a declaration to the Custodian on March 24, 1942. He was evacuated on August 4, 1942.

In his declaration he reported \$50.00 in War Saving Certificates in his own possession. These do not come under the control of this office. He declared policy no. 796089 with the Manufacturers Life Insurance Co. On November 11, 1943, we sent to this man the Manufacturers Life Insurance Co. cheque for \$54.96 in payment of the cash surrender value of this policy. The cheque was payable to himself and his father.

On January 18, 1946, this man sent us a claim for \$70.00 for refund of expenses incurred in the impounding of the vessel "S.T.". Claim in connection with these expenses had been filed with the Japanese Fishing Vessel Disposal Committee in the name of Sadakichi TAKAMATSU, father of this man and the sum of \$50.25 in full settlement of this claim had been credited to the account of Sadakichi TAKAMATSU, who wrote us on February 11, 1946, informing us that these expenses had been incurred by his son, Sadao, and asking us to credit this money to the account of his son. Transfer of these funds is being made today.

This file shows no further property of any kind.


