

Re: Policy #503,720 - Sadakichi TAKAMATSU

Referring to your letter of the 10th instant, the above Japanese and his wife, Tetsu TAKAMATSU, returned to Japan on October 2nd, 1946. Their present whereabouts is unknown to us, and we have no knowledge as to where you would inquire to obtain this information.

These two Japanese were both repatriates, and their assets vested in the Custodian at the time of repatriation. Mr. and Mrs. TAKAMATSU are both indebted to the Canadian Government, and if there are any benefits accruing from the above numbered policy these benefits should be forwarded to the Custodian of Enemy Property.

If you could advise us of the present standing of this policy as to cash surrender value and the date of last premiums paid, it would be appreciated.
