This 37-year old Millhand, a Japanese National, from Woodfibre, B. C., signed a Custodian "JP" declaration form on the 20th March, 1942. He was evacuated on the 21st March, 1942, at which time he was not married.

Real Property: None.

Liabilities: See Liabilities Summary, dated 21st October, 1946, for particulars of only claim on file, which has been liquidated.

Bills Receivable: A claim of \$600.00 owing by Mrs. Sakie Takasaki (File 8710) was admitted (Sept. 7/44) by Debtor and paid in full by transfer into this account (Sept. 15/44).

Another balance, also of \$600.00 with the Royal Bank of Canada, Hastings & Main Sts., Vancouver, did not come under the administration of this office.



We are in receipt of your letter of the 5th instant requesting the remittance of the balance of your funds in Custodian's hands.

This request has necessitated a review of your file and we give below a brief resume of the contents thereof.

The only assets declared by you were the following:

Bills Receivable: A claim against Mrs. Sakie TAKASAKI (File 8710) for the sum of \$600.00. This debt was acknowledged by debtor and a settlement was effected on September 15th, 1944, by means of a transfer from her account to yours.

Bonds, Shares, etc.: A Victory Bond (\$50.00) and War Savings Certificates (16) declared by you remained in your possession and did not come under our administration.

Bank Accounts: A balance of \$600.00 with the Royal Bank of Canada, Vancouver, declared by you, remained under your control.

Another balance, also of \$600.00 declared by you to be in an account with the Japan & Canada Trust Savings Company, could not be traced in the Company's records and is therefore assumed to have been withdrawn by you.

Funds: There is a balance of \$460.00 standing at the credit of your account at the present time and in compliance with your request, referred to at the beginning of this letter, we enclose our cheque, in your favour for this amount, which will leave no balance in your account, which will then be closed.

This would appear to account for all property of every kind left by you in the protected area which vested in the Custodian, and in order that you may confirm this, we enclose a stamped addressed envelope for your convenience.
