In confirmation of our short talk over the phone the other day re renting some of their farms here. The following parties who spoke to me some time ago to get them a tenant, I have succeeded in getting what I consider men who are very capable of handling the crops and taking good care of the said farms herein mentioned, provided this meets with your approval.

Shire Koga - 15 acres partly under cultivation, located on the West side of 10th Avenue, Hanby. Rent \$10.00 per month out of which the 1942 taxes have to be paid.

S. Koga - 10 acres partly under cultivation on the East side of 10th Avenue, Hanby. Rented on Half Crop payments.

I. Ooto - 7 acres all cleared some crop in small fruits, balance to be cultivated and cropped. Rent \$12.00 per month or Half Crop payments.

M. Sakiyama - As I informed you previously, I have sold this place to Mr. Kinner for \$2,000.00. (East side of 14th Avenue)

As soon as I get your approval I will draw up a lease for each and have an inventory taken in each case of the goods now on the place.

Anything I undertake shall be subject to your approval as I had a short talk with Mrs. MacArthur, your representative, to-day and she advised me to write you as I have done.
