He is my nephew who was here in this country until 1941 and is now living under duress in Japan and he wishes to ^{turn} get the money to me and then I can send him food parcels accordingly. The balance shown in his account book is \$107.²⁵/₁₀₀.

Re: Seichi WATANABE, in Japan.

This will acknowledge receipt of your letter of the 28th July, with enquiry re balance in the Japan & Canada Trust Savings Co. for credit of the above.

Please be informed that as Mr. Watanabe was a resident of Japan at the outbreak of War, all of his assets in Canada vest in the Custodian, and all assets which formerly belonged to residents of belligerent areas are to be held by the Custodian, and disposition will depend upon the terms of the Treaties of Peace, so that in the meantime, release of these funds can not be considered.
