GENERAL SUMMARY

File No. 2629

Re: Yasuo MATSUO, Reg. No. 09307

This man signed a declaration to the Custodian on April 8, 1942, in which he stated that he owned no property of any kind in the protected area. He was evacuated on April 11, 1942.

No property of any kind belonging to this man came under the control of the Custodian with the exception of the sum of \$36.44, which was received from Mr. J. M. Streight, Official Administrator, who administered the Estate of Shigeru MATSUO, deceased mother of Yasuo MATSUO. This sum has been credited to the account of Yasuo MATSUO.

One claim has been filed against Yasuo MATSUO, that of M. Ebisuzaki & Co. in the amount of \$25.60. This claim has been referred to Yasuo MATSUO, who has not acknowledged our letter. Money Order for \$25.60 was sent to this office by Yasuo MATSUO in May 1947 for payment of claim.
