

This man signed a declaration to the Custodian on March 23, 1942. He was evacuated on April 21, 1942.

In his declaration he reported kitchen utensils, gasoline boat and fishing tackle left at Sunnyside Cannery. In April, 1942, Mr. Dave Smith visited this Cannery and reported he could not find any property of value belonging to this man at Sunnyside Cannery.

He reported a debt owing to him of \$100.00 by T. KUTSUKAKI. He wrote TAKIZAWA several times for more information but received no reply and are therefore taking no further action.
