In his declaration he reported a sewing machine, Micthen utensils, 2 kegs of sauce and a wicker clothes basket at Clarton Cannery. There is no disposition shown on the file of the sewing machine but as shipments were made from the canneries without the knowledge of this office we assume this was shipped direct to TANL. The remainder of his chattels were sold at auction and the net proceeds in the amount of \$54.99 were credited to his account. We are remitting

He reported three \$5.00 War Savings Certificates in his own possession. These did not come under the control of this office.

The records of the Japanese Fishing Vessels Disposal Committee show that this man was the owner of a vessel "S.T. #1" which was sold and the net proceeds in the amount of \$344.00 were paid to TANI through his attorney, R. YOSHIDA.
