Dear Sir:

A year or so ago through the courtesy of Mr. W. E. Everson of Lethbridge, you were good enough to dispose of certain shares of the Pacific Cooperative Union.

My mother has two certificates of the above Union, No. 312, for 33 shares and No. 1715 for 5 shares, each valued at \$10.00. My uncle, M. Yahihiro who died August 2nd, 1942, was also the owner of the following: No. 1716 - 4 shares, and No. 313 - 7 shares.

May I ask you to dispose of these certificates and remit the receipts to the undersigned at 54 Shirley St., Toronto.

On a former occasion when shares made out in my uncle's name were sent to you, you were good enough to dispose of them but held the money pending a settlement of his estate. By this time, no doubt, the Will has been probated. If such is the case and you are free to release the money, may I not ask you to send the proceeds of the former sale as well as the one about which I am writing you now to me?

Re: Pacific Co-operative Union Shares

We have received through the Department of Labour, in their letter of March 19, 1948, a copy of your letter written to us on March 11, 1947, enquiring about the redemption of the above mentioned shares.

We attach hereto a statement of your mother's account, Mrs. Kin YAHIRO, and a statement of your deceased uncle's account, Masuo YAHIRO. On these statements you will find entries for the redemption of all Pacific Co-operative Union shares, with the number of the certificate shown beside each redemption. The shares which have not yet been redeemed are certificate #312 for thirty-three shares, and certificate #313 for seven shares. These shares are non-redeemable and no arrangement has been made as yet for any cash payment to be made for them. Should any action be taken in the future regarding these shares you will be so advised.

This letter and the statements should give you all the information you desire.

We are today forwarding to your mother a cheque for \$1.34, covering last interest paid on Pacific Co-operative Union shares.
