THIS COURT DOTH FURTHER ORDER and ADJUDGE that the Plaintiff's General Damages be and the same are hereby assessed at \$250.00.

THIS COURT DOTH FURTHER ORDER and ADJUDGE that the Plaintiff do recover from the Defendant the sum of \$319.84 such sum being 75% of the aggregate of the Plaintiff's Special and General Damages as hereby assessed.

THIS COURT DOTH FURTHER ORDER and ADJUDGE that the costs of the Plaintiff and the Defendant respectively be taxed and that the Plaintiff recover an amount equal to 75% of his taxed costs and that the Defendant recover an amount equal to 25% of his taxed costs and that the one be set off against the other, and that if the difference
