
Miss YAMASAKI certified on April 13, 1943 that she had clothing worth \$25.00 and one Singer Sewing machine, treadle, left in her brother's house, foot of Trites Road, Steveston, B. C. A letter from Miss YAMASAKI dated April 27, 1942 stated that she will take the sewing machine with her when she will leave for Alberta. However, it was revealed on her brother's file, Toshio YAMASAKI, Reg. No. 08040, File No. 9091, that one sewing machine was shipped on May 11, 1943 by the tenant A. F. Douglas, who had the permission of the B. C. Security Commission and the Custodian.

As it was impossible to identify the clothing belonging to Miss YAMASAKI, clothing taken from her brother's house and sold at auction in the amount of \$2.00, the credit remained in her brother's account. Clothing that had been discarded as being in very poor condition could not be identified as belonging to Miss YAMASAKI or to her brother.


