

She also declares 1 Singer Sewing Machine stored at the Crane Storage Co. Ltd., and letter dated April 17, 1942, with notation from Crane Storage confirms her declaration. Nothing further on file regarding this machine.

There is no evidence on file of any other assets belonging to the above Japanese.
