He declared skis left at the Fuji Ski Club, Grouse Mountain. In our letter to him of Dec. 7/42 we advised him of our inability to recover skis from some unknown place. His letter of Dec. 17/42 would indicate that he recovered these skis or abandoned them, or left them on Grouse Mountain. ??? He says SOLD!!!

ACCOUNTS RECEIVABLE: The account of the above was credited with the sum of \$5.11, being a refund of 1% wage deductions for 1941, and a custodian cheque for this amount was remitted to him on Jan. 3/44.
